**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – Section 14(1)**

Notice of Temporary Traffic Order  
Wardington A361 - Prohibition of Through Traffic

Date of Order: 10 October 2011

Coming into force: 17 October 2011

This Order is being introduced because of carriageway patching and iron works which are anticipated to take three days to complete.

The effect of the Order is to temporarily prohibit any vehicle proceeding in the length of the A361 between its junctions with the road to Edgcote and the road that runs between the A361 and Top Dawkins.

Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed to indicate when the measures are in force.

Exemptions are included for police, fire and ambulance services and for the works and for access to premises which are only accessible from the closed section of road.

The alternative route for traffic affected by the closure is via the A422 through Banbury, the A423 to Southam and the A425 to Daventry.

This closure is being put in place to coincide with the existing Northants CC closure of the A361 at Chacombe and its diversion route.

This Order will remain in force for a maximum period of 18 months or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner.
